



The Indonesian Global Internship Program is the Government of Indonesia scholarship scheme to fund Indonesian students for internships at top companies and organizations overseas.

Undergraduate and applied bachelor/vocational students could spend **one semester** at the overseas company and organization partners to practice what they have learned in a real world, gain a better understanding of industries, companies and careers, innovate and get creative in solving problems, and experience work culture in different countries.

The scheme is centrally managed by Directorate General of Higher Education(DGHE), Ministry of Education and Culture (MoECRT) and is open for undergraduate and vocational students from all Indonesian higher education institutions under MoECRT.



INTERNSHIP JOURNEY

1. Get to know the host company on the website 2. Find a letter of recommendation from the home university 3. Fill in the application form 4. Check the acceptance to the interview selection stage 5. Attend the selection interview as scheduled 6. Check the final announcement 7. Attend pre-departure series 8. Attend the judicial 9. Departure to host company 10. Fill in the logbook and carry out assignments 11. Return to the home university 12. Collect physical documents and get recognition of 20 credits from home university









ELIGIBILITY (STUDENTS)

To apply for Indonesian Global Internship Program, you must (be):

- enrolled as an active Undergraduate Indonesian Student of recognized universities in Indonesia under the Directorate of Higher Education, Culture, Research, and Technology (DGHERT) or as an active vocational student under Directorate General of Vocational Education during the application and the program;
- **Q2** an Indonesian citizen (WNI) currently residing in Indonesia and do not have dual citizenship;
- in the 6th semester (for Undergraduate); the 4th semester (for Diploma 3), and the 6th semester (for applied bachelor/D4) when apply;
- never have taken college leave during their undergraduate/vocational study;
- have a cumulative GPA of a minimum 3.0 (out of 4.0) proven by the latest academic transcript;
- have adequate English proficiency with a minimum score of IELTS 6.0, TOEFL iBT 78, Duolingo English Test 100*









ELIGIBILITY (STUDENTS)

To apply for Indonesian Global Internship Program, you must (be):

- **07** nominated by the Vice Rector of Academic Affairs of your home university and obtain approval letter from the head of the study program;
- not receive the living allowance from the other funding/scholarship from the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology and Indonesian Endowment Fund (Lembaga Pengelola Dana Pendidikan LPDP) during the IGIP Program;
- op not participating in other Kampus Merdeka programs at the same time as the Indonesian Global Internship Program;
- 10 not take courses at home University during the program
- 17 never have violated the rules, norms, and/or laws applied in Indonesia;
- 79 Agree to follow the rules and regulations while participating in Indonesian Global Internship Program









REQUIRED DOCUMENTS (STUDENTS)

- Recommendation letter signed by Head of International Office on behalf of Vice Rector of Academic Affairs.
- **Q2** Valid English proficiency certificate (IELTS (min score 7.0)/TOEFL-iBT (min score 70)/Duolingo(min score 105).
- O3 Official Academic transcript (in English).
- O4 Clearance from Narcotic, Psychotropic, or other addictive substances from public health care or hospital
- O5 Curriculum Vitae and short video describing applicant, skills, and motivation
- 06 Non-Involvement in Sexual Violence (statement letter sign by parents
